SPECIAL FEATURES

SELECTION PROCEDURE: The selection of the needy students is solely done by the class teacher. The completed application forms of the selected girls are forwarded by the Principal to the trust. The payment of scholarships are made through cheques and the amount is distributed amongst the students by the Principal in the presence of higher authorities of the education department. Records are maintained in each school vide an order of the Director, Education Department, Rajasthan (Serial No. Shivira/Ma/E-2/Sundries/22605/ dated 26.11.97.

ZERO ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENDITURE: All administrative expenses of the trust are borne personally by the trustees. There is no voucher system in the trust.

<u>DEPOSITS</u>: The contributions collected by the trust are deposited in banks and the interest accrued is given to the principal through cheques for distributing to the needy girls as scholarship.

<u>BHAMASHAH AWARD</u>: The relentless efforts by President Shri Nandkishore Sharda in promoting girls education has resulted in the trust being honoured consequently five times with the prestigious State Level Bhamashah Award by the Government of Rajasthan. Besides, the trust has also been honoured by the Department of Education from time to time.

INCOME TAX EXEMPTION: The trust has been exempted under section 80G of the Income Tax Act.

OTHER ACTIVITIES

- 1) FREE DISTRIBUTION OF BOOKS:- The trust has distributed free of cost over ninety thousand books on Lord Ramakrishna Paramhansa, Maa Sharda Mani, Swami Vivekanand, Bhagwan Mahaveer etc. amongst over 9000 students. This project has been taken with a view to enlighten the students of their spiritual heritage so as to inculcate high moral values in them.
- 2) MAA SHARDA MANI TRUST:- For the upliftment of girls education, Shri Nand Kishore Sharda established this trust on 28th March, 2001. The trust pays fees, and provides free text books to all college girls adopted by the trust through the "Maa Sharda Mani Book Bank". From session 2001-02 to 2010-11, an amount of Rs. 6,77,440/- has been distributed amongst 484 needy girls.
- 3) <u>BUILDINGS & FURNITURE</u>:- Kumari Basanti Manihar, Shri NandKishore Sharda and their associates donated generously for the construction of "Kumari Basanti Manihar Commerce Block" in Mahila Mahavidhyalaya, Pratap Nagar. They also donated for the construction of classrooms in "Mahalaxmi Girl's Senior Secondary School" Pratap Nagar. In addition, they have also provided for furniture, water huts, boundary walls, etc. in many schools.

In the session 2005-06, a temple of Maa Saraswati was built in Govt. Girls Senior Secondary School, Jalori-Gate and furniture for a classroom was donated to Govt. Girls Senior Secondary School, Sardarpura.
